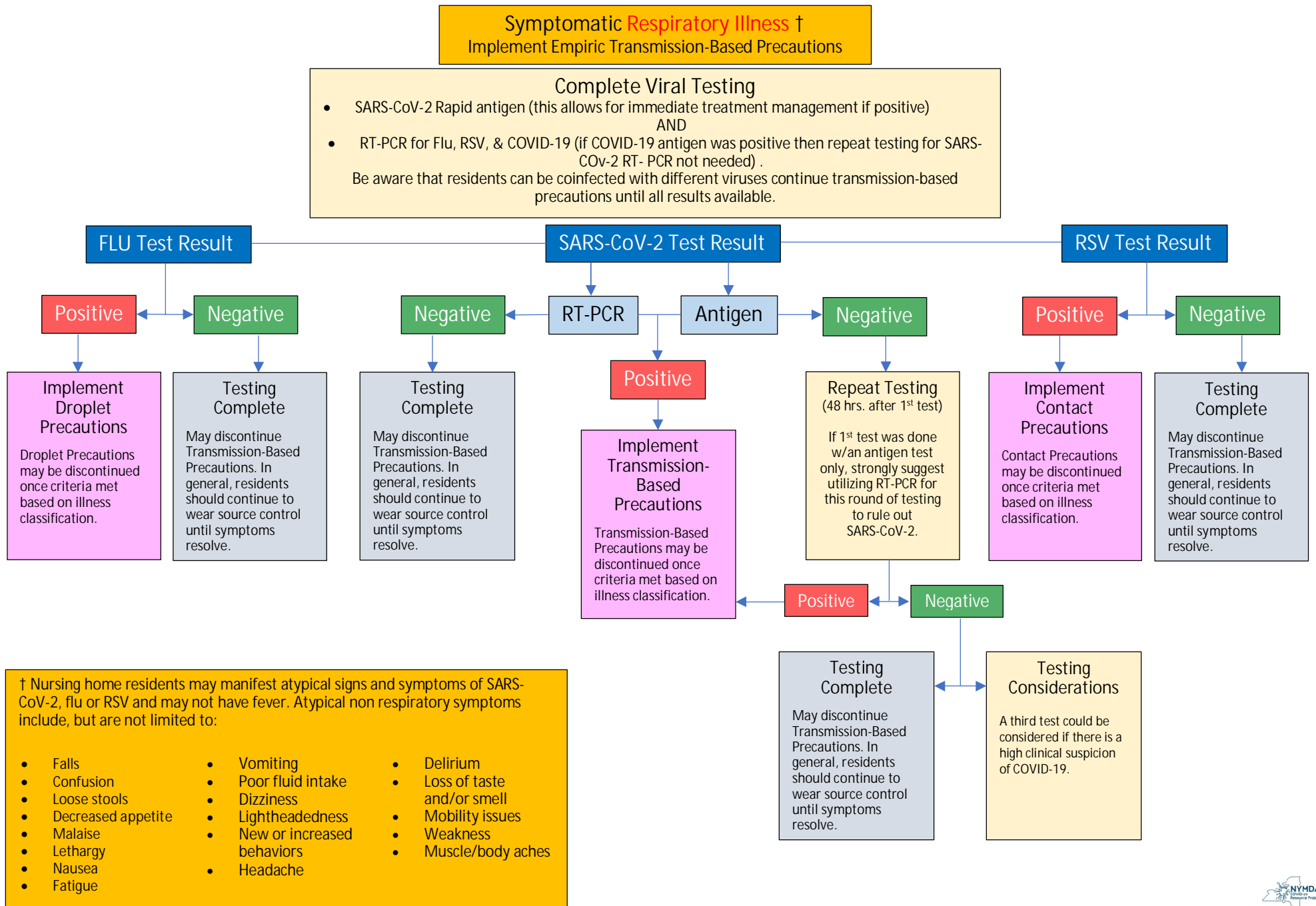


Respiratory Viral Testing and Isolation Recommendations for Symptomatic Resident with No Known Exposures to COVID-19 When other Viruses are Circulating



† Nursing home residents may manifest atypical signs and symptoms of SARS-CoV-2, flu or RSV and may not have fever. Atypical non respiratory symptoms include, but are not limited to:

- Falls
- Confusion
- Loose stools
- Decreased appetite
- Malaise
- Lethargy
- Nausea
- Fatigue
- Vomiting
- Poor fluid intake
- Dizziness
- Lightheadedness
- New or increased behaviors
- Headache
- Delirium
- Loss of taste and/or smell
- Mobility issues
- Weakness
- Muscle/body aches
